Though we have begun to roll out options in new Online formats and are still carefully monitoring the development of this pandemic, we wish to make clear that we endorse NO SPECIFIC SCHEDULE FOR RESUMING IN-PERSON LIVE EVENTS amid Covid-19, but rather we are deferring to a CLIENT'S LOCAL, STATE, AND/OR NATIONAL DIRECTIVES, REGULATIONS, RESTRICTIONS AND GUIDELINES as to whether and how our practitioners may eventually resume in-person sessions and/or live group events in your area. If you as a Breathworker intend on resuming in-person, hands-on events, including private sessions, TBF requires you to send us a detailed accounting of the safety protocols that you commit to installing for client and staff safety, and to read and sign the release below.
